## Prepare & Gather Your Materials

- Draw your design idea on a piece of paper.
- Find a piece of fabric: cotton, felt, or even a piece of old clothing.
- Launder and iron the fabric, if needed.
- Cut the fabric into a 12 ½-inch by 12 ½-inch square.

## Create Your Quilt Square

- Sew your square, leaving a ¼-inch undecorated border.
- Or using thread, markers, sequins, glue, and other craft materials, create your design on the piece of cloth, leaving a ¼-inch undecorated border.

## Share Your Quilt Square

- Once finished, take a photo of your square and share it on social media using hashtag #QuiltsForACause.
- Place the square inside a clean plastic or paper bag to prevent any damage, and put it in a safe, dry place.
- Once the Library is open to the public again, drop off your square at a local Library branch.
- Once the Library has received all the squares, they will be sewn into a quilt(s) to be auctioned off by the Library Foundation of Cincinnati and Hamilton County to fund important Library programs like Homework Help and summer learning activities for youth.
