



7 WAYS TO MAKE THE MOST OF SUMMER

- Talk with your child to find out what they are interested in.
 Then, take them to the Library to learn more.
- Visit the Library to find new books for your family.
- Kids learn best when they try things themselves. Explore new ideas through art, writing, or play.
- * Be active! Get outside and explore your neighborhood.
- * Come to a free library program to meet other parents and kids.
- Give your child time at home to help them become creative and independent.
- Celebrate when your child learns something new!





Discover Summer is designed to help kids love reading and learning for the rest of their lives!

Discover Their Own Adventures

When kids get to explore what interests them, they want to keep learning. Help them find books and activities about their interests.

Build Curiosity

Ask your child open-ended questions to help them stay curious. This booklet has ways to help kids find what excites them.

Grow Confidence

Lifelong learners don't know everything, and that is okay! Setbacks can be an opportunity to develop confidence. Talk about it: What is hard about this? How can we get through it? How does it feel to solve the problem?






Connect the Dots

Draw dots on a piece of paper and then connect them. Or, ask someone else to play!




Tip for Grownups
